Notes for Pedro Oliverio Sanchez:

Pedro's life was defined by being the only child of the prominent Cristoval Sanchez and Placida Chaves. His father's profession as school teacher, rancher, and later, a school superintendent and legislator, meant that he would certainly have his son well schooled at the Christian Brother's St. Michael's College in Santa Fe. This was a unique educational privilege of the children of well-to-do ranchers and merchants of the late nineteenth century New Mexico. Pedro was to witness as a young man the slow demise of his father. After his father's death in the Spring of 1907, his mother was to send that Summer a letter seeking the hand in marriage of the neighbor's daughter, Maria Filomena Duran. This letter and copies still survive. Living in the ranch at the time was the adopted Adelina, a servant, but probably niece of Placida, that was brought over from Conejos, Colorado, and also, a ranch hand and servant named Nestor Duran.

By inheriting 1,100 acres of prime farming and grazing land as well as his childhood home, Pedro's educational level permitted him to be a successful rancher, especially during the World War I years. He was to serve in the New Mexico Legislature and also served for a period of time as Mora County Deputy Sheriff. He was one of the first persons to own an automobile in this area of Mora County. His life was to be cut short by a brain hemorrhage that afflicted him at his ranch in September of 1929. His two grown sons would manage the ranch for their mother after his death. Adding to the heavy burden of having most of her children young and still at home, the widow Filomena was pregnant at the time and would go into a long mourning period. This was affecting her family. Cristobal would later tell his wife of his words to his mother to stop the mourning since his father hadn't loved them and that it was a known fact in the Ocate area that he had already been planning to leave the family and go live with his pregnant girlfriend. Grandmother Filomena was also pregnant at the time of Pedro's death. This child, Ila Jo, was born on about March of 1930 and was to die of pneumonia eight months after birth. The girlfriend's name was never spoken of and her male child was also born in 1930. Little is known about this boy other than what was reported by the Sanchez daughters Placida and Fabiola said that he looked much like young Gilbert Sanchez.

Jose was known as Jose M. Duran y Romero (using his mother's maiden name) to differentiate from several other Jose M. Durans living in this area of Mora County.

Census: 1900, Oldest child listed by a previous marriage was Juan Ysidro Duran, born Dec. 1879. Also children: Pilar: (Oct. 1882), Alejandro (April 1886), Daniel (Mar 1888), Filomena (July 1892), Bernardo (June 1894), and Jose (March 1897).

Notes for Franck Metzger:

In the 1860 US Census, Franck is listed as living in St. Getrudes, Mora, NM, gives his age as 41. a merchant, and birth country of PreuBen, Prussia, which is now a province of Germany. He is shown alone, unmarried, but obviously seeing or living with Maria Polonia and has several daughters by this time off of her. Maria is still married to Bernardo Martin, a land owner, whose much older than Maria. It is not known whether Franck ever officially married Maria and legitimized his daughters. His age is apparently not correct as immigration paper have him listed as arriving in the USA from Prussia and birth date of 1913.

By 1870, the US Census lists him living with Maria and lists his three legitimate daughters. HIs business partner is a younger HenryKorte, a fellow german (age 40) who married his oldest daughter Maria Juanita.

More About Franck Metzger:

Burial: Buena Vista, Mora, NM

Business: F. Metzger was listed in the 1870 US Census as being in the Dry Goods Mercantile business with his son-in-law Henry Korte.
